

1f. Code of Behaviour – Spectator

1. Remember all children play football for their enjoyment, not just yours.
2. Applaud good play and performances from both teams and be forward in congratulating all individuals and teams.
3. Respect the decisions of the officials and teach children to do the same.
4. Never ridicule or scold a young player for making a mistake. Positive comments motivate us all.
5. Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials or players.
6. Show respect to both teams regardless of outcome.
7. Encourage the players to follow the rules and accept the decisions of the match official.
8. Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.
9. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

Any breaches of this Code of Behaviour will be referred to the Soccer (Football) Committee for an appropriate course of action. Breaches may result in a caution or formal letter of warning being issued. Continuous infringements of the same nature will result in match bans and ultimately exclusion from the DOC United Football Club.
